2. This is a face characterized by:

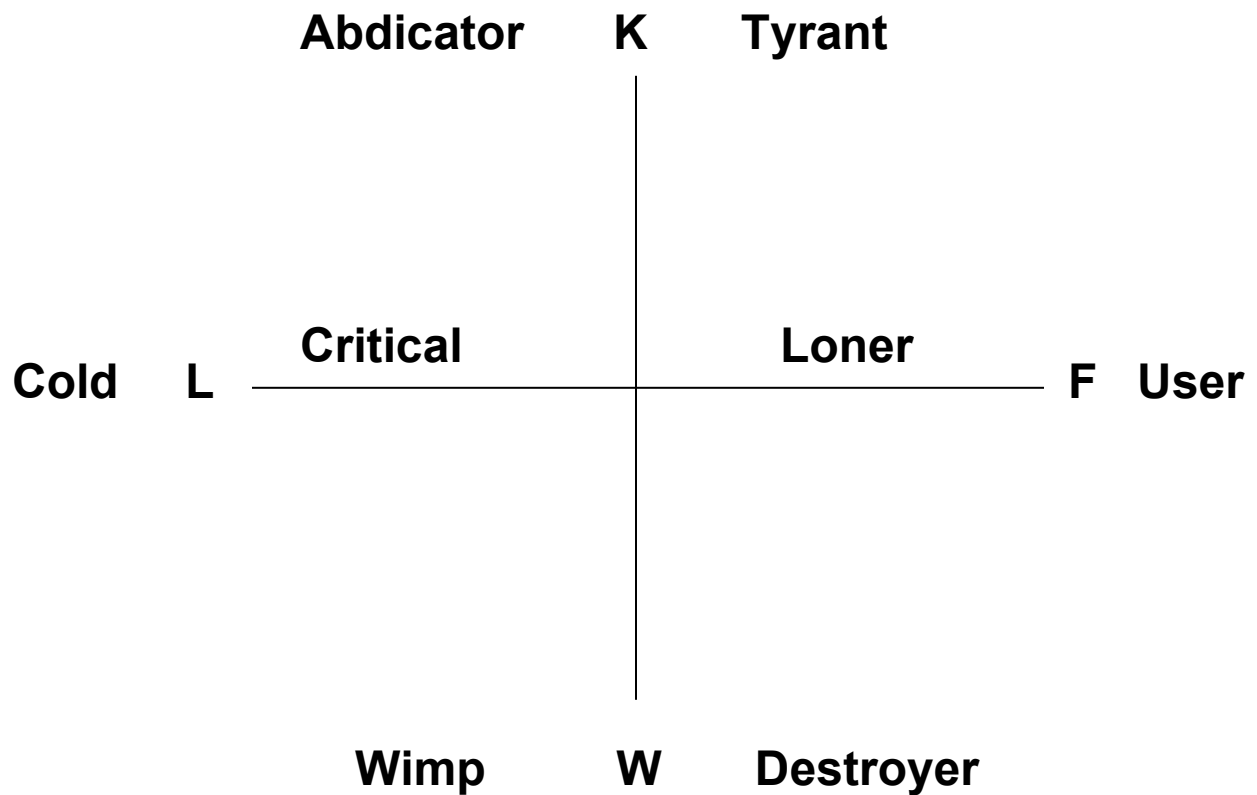
- Loyalty

Some Important Observations About These Four Faces

A. All too often, these honorable faces of manhood are replaced by ugly caricatures.



B. Because of our morally-compromised culture, many men today lack a King.
